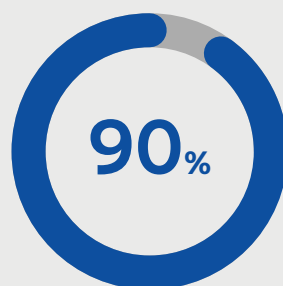

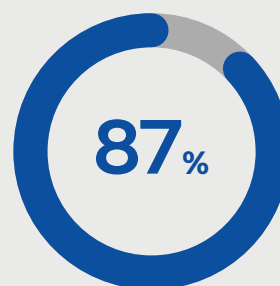

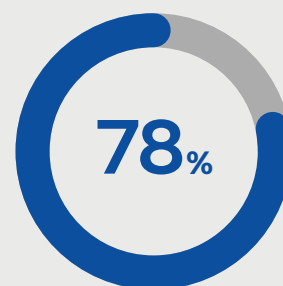

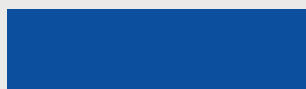


An EU that protects against global challenges

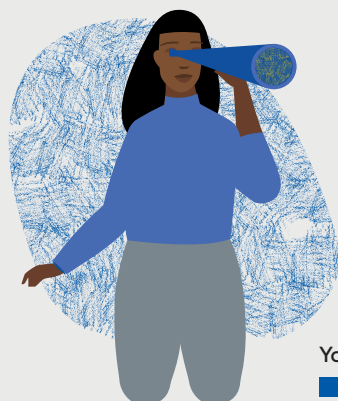
The main priorities young citizens believe the European Parliament should address*:

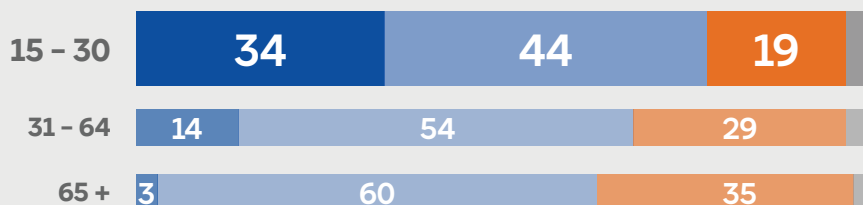
